"Trading in our core UK markets in 2011 continues to be challenging as indicated in our statements earlier in the year. The Board is confident in Morson's continued strategy of focussing on long term relationships with blue chip customers and capitalising on our market leading position in a broad spread of markets. The Group's prospects and trading are in line with directors' expectations. We remain well positioned to gain market share when improving economic conditions occur.

The acquisition of the remaining issued capital of our joint venture subsidiary, Morson Wynnwith, earlier this year has proceeded to plan and this business has been fully integrated within the Group. We continue to evaluate and seek growth opportunities and will make selective investments where they will add value for shareholders."
